DISCOVER HOW THE BENEFIT AUCTION WORKS

STEP 1 OFFER A LOT FOR

THE PROFIT-AUCTION

From December 15th, 2021, until February 1st 2022

Should you wish to offer a lot* to the profit-auction online, simply fill out the form (link available in French in this document): Encan Bénéfice 2022 (smartsheet.com)

In giving the lot, the donor undertakes to send it to the buyer (by post or by hand).

Useful information for donors:

- You can offer as many lots as you want
- Do not hesitate to integrate a beautiful photo of your lot!
- The minimum starting price for the lots offered is \$25
- You can decide to which association/club the income from the sale of your lot will be donated, or leave it to the free choice of the buyer
- Lot information must be received by February 1, 2022

* No lot whose sale is prohibited or regulated according to the legislation in force (e.g. bottle of alcohol) will be accepted as a lot of the benefit auction (www.racj.gouv.qc.ca).

STEP 2 BET ON A LOT

To bet, write a comment under the publication of the lot.

- + Auction opens: Tuesday, February 15 at midnight
- + Auction closes: Tuesday 01 March at 7am pm.

 By betting, the buyer agrees to pay the lot within seven (7) days of the end of the benefit auction

 Cheval Québec is the intermediary between donor and buyer but is not responsible for withdrawals. In case of non-payment, the prize goes to the next person who made the highest bet.

STEP 3 COLLECT/DELIVER YOUR LOT

After the deadline, the person who offered the highest amount wins the prize.

To pay for your prize online:

The buyer is invited to pay for his lot via Interac e-Transfer or cheque.

- Payment by bank transfer sent to comptabilite@cheval.quebec The response of the transfer must be Cheval
- **1** You must write the number of the lot for which you pay in the section Raison
- Payment confirmation by e-mail

Once payment is received, Cheval Québec connects the donor and the buyer. Depending on the situation, the prize won could be:

- ✓ delivered to the buyer (at his expense)
- ✓ hand-delivered
- \checkmark given to the buyer according to any agreement with the donor

The proceeds from the online benefit auction are then entirely donated to equestrian associations and clubs affiliated with Cheval Québec!
